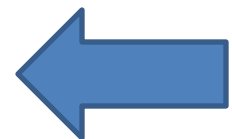
Half Yearly Examination

Examination till 06 Dec 2017

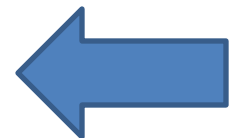

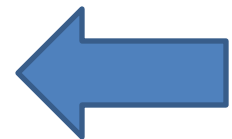

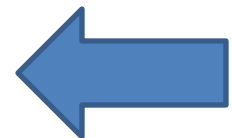

Flexibility in choosing subjects

- Candidates with visual and hearing impairment, Spastic, Dyslexic, Autistic and candidates with disabilities as defined in THE RIGHTS OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES ACT 2016 have the option of studying one compulsory language as against two.

Scribe and compensatory time

Spastic, Visually Impaired, Physically Handicapped, Dyslexic, Autistic and candidates with disabilities as defined in THE RIGHTS OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES ACT 2016 are permitted to use a Scribe or allowed Compensatory time as given below or both :

- For paper of 3 hours duration : 60 minutes
- For paper of 2½ hours duration : 50 minutes
- For paper of 2 hours duration : 40 minutes
- For paper of 1½ hours duration : 30 minutes

Autistic candidate is permitted to use the services of a scribe or an Adult prompter.
